MEETING MINUTES

Regular Meeting called to order at 6:32 p.m. by Board President Tammy Kline

Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

Minutes of the board's February 19, 2025 regular meeting were reviewed. Motion to approve as corrected by Guy; seconded by Perkins. Vote: 3-0, to approve.

Fire Department Report

Chief Jeff White was not in attendance. Trustee Carroll told the board the West Side Fire Garage is "nearly operational," and departmental materials are being taken there. He said the department is responding to frequent calls during this historically busy time of the year.

Financial Reports

Financial activity reports through February 28, 2025, as well as the First Federal Savings Bank reconciliation report, were reviewed. No substantive questions were raised about the reports. Motion to approve by Guy; seconded by Perkins. Vote: 3-0.
Trustee Carroll informed the board that project carryovers from 2024 to 2025 will likely require additional adjustments to the 2025 budget in the months to come.

Trustee Report

Trustee Carroll reported that relief assistance traffic was "pretty slow" in February. In his Grounds Report, Trustee Carroll reported that landscaping work was completed on the south end of the park on March 11, plants have been installed at the opening to the storage cubby, and a ditch, maintained by the County Drainage Board, along the southwest boundary of the park property, has been "cleared well" for spring. The Fitness Park will be open "before spring break" in early April, he added.

New Business

Trustee Carroll will be out of town the week of April 6, and the board decided to move the April meeting back one week, to Wednesday, April 16.

Old Business

Trustee Carroll told the board that the videotaping of Township Board meetings, to begin this summer, will probably be conducted via Zoom, which offers a longer archiving option than YouTube.
