MEETING MINUTES

Regular Meeting called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Board President Tammy Kline

Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

Minutes of the board's May 14, 2025 regular meeting were reviewed. Motion to approve by Guy; seconded by Perkins. Vote: 3-0, to approve.

Fire Department Report

In Chief White's absence, there was no Fire Department report.

Financial Reports

- Financial activity reports through May 31, 2025, as well as the First Federal Savings Bank reconciliation report, were reviewed. No substantive questions were raised about the reports. Motion to approve by Guy; seconded by Perkins. Vote: 3-0.

- Financial Clerk Sherry Miller advised the board to expect a fund transfer request within the Parks and Recreation budget to be on the July meeting agenda. The transfer amount will cover construction of additional restroom facilities and a limited-mobility access pier at the north end of Lake Clare as well as additional maintenance costs and possibly an insurance premium increase, she said. Trustee Carroll said all budget categories "look good so far" this year and that he is pleased the township "has done some projects on things we won't have to mess with for a while."

Trustee Report

Trustee Carroll reported that relief assistance applications have "picked up a bit" in recent weeks, but the number remains "nothing out of the ordinary."

He reminded the board that, beginning with the July meeting, all board meeting video and audio will be live-streamed and archived on a new township website, created specially for that purpose. More details on where and how to access the site, @huntingtontownship.org, will be forthcoming.

Trustee Carroll said the park's new chip-and-seal drive has been applied and is curing. The project cost \$16,000 and was completed by Hasty's Asphalt and Sealcoating. He said the township's new mower is onsite and weed- and grass-control measures have been taken.

Trustee Carroll said the May 30-June 1 boat race crowd was down a bit from previous years, probably the result of chilly, windy weather for the competition. He showed the board an award trophy presented by the race's sanctioning body, the American Power Boat Association, naming Lake Clare the organization's Best Race Site 2024. A triathlon is scheduled for the park June 6-89, he added.

He also said trash receptacle along the Lake Clare shore have been removed to alleviate improper dumping.

New Business

Tim Guy advised Trustee Carroll to consider installing kayak launch at lake Clare to attract area kayakers to the site, saying it "could really be an asset" for the park.

Trustee Carroll reported that, end-of-month financial reports from First Federal Savings Bank will be received by the township later in the month. He is uncertain how that might affect the timelines of reports to the board.

He said he expects to see repairs to the main entrance structures begin soon.

Trustee Carroll also said the department might sell "Mike," its utility vehicle, but a final decision has not been made.

Old Business

There was no old business conducted.
